Face Shield Update!


The first order of new Face Shields have arrived and have been distributed. I am sure by now that you have probably heard that the face shields are now a mandatory piece of sparring equipment. Here are the official rules regarding face shields: As of the 2007 Songahm Taekwondo World Championships, faceshields have now become a mandatory piece of sparring equipment for tournament participation and in all Songahm Taekwondo sanctioned events hereafter for ALL ages of competitors. This includes all Class C, Class B, Class A, Class AA, Class AAA sanctioned

events and any other events sanctioned by the WTTU International Headquarters. It has been reported by school owners that are already using face shields that their students have shown a greater sense of security during sparring training. This helps alleviate the "fear factor" that comes with sparring training. There has also been an upswing in the number of facial injuries as of late. Our competitors are becoming faster and more proficient with advanced level techniques in the sparring ring. If a defender makes a miscalculation in their movement or is caught "offguard" it does not take much impact to cause a facial injury. It is the ATA's goal to create the safest competition environment possible.

ATA Songahm Taekwondo History!

During its early years, the ATA used the Chang-hun style of forms (also used by the International Taekwondo Federation). Although this style was widely accepted in the Taekwondo community, Eternal Grand Master Lee felt that its forms did not accurately reflect Taekwondo—particularly the

strength and beauty of Taekwondo kicking techniques. As a result, he believed, the forms contributed little to the Taekwondo curriculum. For example, white belts were expected to know front kicks and side kicks, but no front kick appeared until the third (yellow belt) form. From 1983 to 1990, Eternal Grand

Master Lee introduced the eighteen Songahm forms. These forms are part of a fully-integrated curriculum, in which everything a student learns reinforces everything else. The forms contain nearly all of the techniques that students are expected to know at each rank.

the basic components of each weapon's form and capabilities. We will work on basic techniques and drills for the Single Bahng Mahng-ee (short stick), Single Ssahng Jeol Bong (nunchaku), Double Bahng Mahng-ee (Practice Drills) & Double Ssahng Jeol Bong (Practice Drills). 
